CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES TEST RESULTS NOTIFICATION

The controlled substances testing regulations require the employer to notify a driver of a positive result following a random, reasonable suspicion, or post-accident drug test if the test results are verified positive. In the case of a pre-employment drug test, a driver-applicant requesting results within 60 days of notification of the disposition of her/his employment application must be notified of the results by the employer (49 CFR, subtitle B, Chapter III, part 382, paragraph 382.411).
